## About this One-of-a-Kind Unique Tour:

Magnolia Plantation and Gardens is renowned as the first in the U.S. to plant azaleas outdoors, featuring hundreds of thousands of blooms that peak in spring. Founded in 1676, this romantic-style garden is famous for its massive display of Indian azaleas, including white and purple varieties. The Nature Train Tour winds through miles of wetlands, forests, marsh, and swamp, immersing you in the ecological landscapes of Magnolia. As the train travels through the grounds, the tour highlights the Indigenous communities and the generations of people who lived and labored at Magnolia, weaving their stories into the surrounding landscape.

**Boone Hall Plantation** was founded in 1681 when Englishman Major John Boone came to Charleston and established a lucrative plantation and gracious home on the banks of Wampacheone Creek. The family and descendants of Major Boone were influential in the history of South Carolina, the colonies and the nation. In 1743, the son of Major John Boone planted live oak trees, arranging them in two evenly spaced rows. This spectacular approach to his home symbolizes southern heritage and will take root in your memory for many years to come. **CRUISE THROUGH HISTORY:** Climb aboard the Carolina Belle to enjoy the beauty of Charleston Harbor and learn the rich history of the Holy City. **Middleton Place**, a National Historic Landmark near Charleston, SC features America's oldest landscaped gardens (circa 1741), a House Museum, and a restored stableyard. Formerly a massive rice plantation, it offers tours focusing on the lives of the Middleton family - including Declaration of Independence signer Arthur Middleton - and the enslaved people who lived there.

**Charleston City Market**, a beloved landmark in the heart of downtown Charleston, SC. For over 200 years, it has been a hub of activity, showcasing the best of Charleston's unique culture, rich history, and Southern charm. As one of the oldest public markets in the United States, the Market is a must-visit destination for anyone exploring the Holy City. From sweetgrass basket weavers to local artisans, and from fresh seafood to traditional Lowcountry cuisine, this historic market offers a unique and authentic experience that embodies the spirit of Charleston. Whether you're a local or just visiting, it's the perfect place to discover the city's vibrant atmosphere, shop for unique souvenirs, and indulge in the flavors of the Lowcountry.

**The Old Exchange and Provost Dungeon** in Charleston, South Carolina, completed in 1771, served as a British customs house, commercial hub, and, during the Revolutionary War, a brutal British prison. It is one of America's most historic sites, where the Declaration of Independence was read, the Constitution was ratified, and George Washington was welcomed in 1791.


