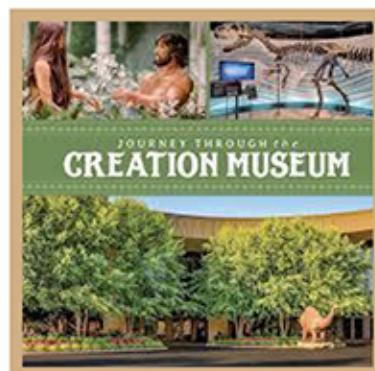
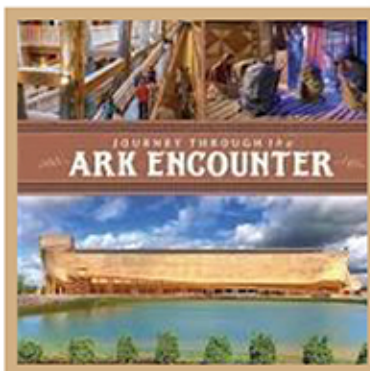

**OCONALUFTEE INDIAN VILLAGE:** Step back in time to the 18th century and immerse yourself in the vibrant culture of the Cherokee people nestled within the picturesque North Carolina mountains. The Oconaluftee Indian Village invites you to embark on a journey unlike any other, offering a captivating glimpse into the past. Explore historical buildings, witness captivating shows such as "Time of War," and be enchanted by traditional Cherokee dancing.

**Museum of the Cherokee People:** Established in 1948, the Museum of the Cherokee People is one of the longest-operating tribal museums in the country. Located in Cherokee, North Carolina on the Qualla Boundary, the sovereign land of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians and ancestral homelands of all Cherokees, the Museum shares the history, culture, and stories of the Cherokee people through its exhibitions, collections, and programs. The Museum of the Cherokee People is the recipient of the Association of Tribal Archives, Libraries, and Museums' 2022 Guardians of Culture and Lifeways International Award and was voted a Top Ten Best Native American Experiences by USA TODAY.

**Unto These Hills:** is a historic outdoor drama in Cherokee, NC, portraying the Cherokee people's journey from European contact through the Trail of Tears. Running for over 75 years at the 2,800-seat Mountainside Theatre, it is one of the oldest outdoor dramas in the US.

**All Aboard!** The historic Great Smoky Mountains Railroad Depot sits in the heart of Bryson City, North Carolina – a favorite regional attraction for family fun. A round-trip on the train is an ideal way to see extraordinary places that you can't get to by car. Get a front-row view of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, Nantahala National Forest, Fontana Lake, extraordinary trestles, pristine mountain rivers, and historic structures.

**Cades Cove** is a popular, scenic 11-mile one-way loop in the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, renowned for its rich history, preserved 19th-century cabins/churches, and prime wildlife viewing (especially black bears, deer, and turkeys). Located near Townsend, TN, this valley attracts millions of visitors exploring the historic landscape.



**Creation Museum:** The state-of-the-art Creation Museum allows you to venture through Biblical history, stunning exhibits, botanical gardens, planetarium, petting zoo, zip line adventure course, and more. This 75,000 sq. ft. facility has welcomed over 2.5 million guests since opening in Petersburg, Kentucky.

The Ark Encounter is situated in beautiful Williamstown, Kentucky.

**Ark Encounter** features a full-size Noah's Ark, built according to the dimensions given in the Bible. Genesis 6 states that the biblical ark was 300 cubits long, 50 cubits wide, and 30 cubits high. Assuming this was a royal cubit (as was typical for large projects in the ancient world), this converts to approximately 510 feet long, 85 feet wide, and 51 feet high. That's huge! Learn more on deck one of the Ark. **This modern engineering marvel is the largest freestanding timber structure in the world and amazes visitors young and old.** Inside the Ark-Inside are three decks of world-class exhibits, illustrating what life aboard the ark may have been like, discussing flood geology and the subsequent ice age, and so much more!



**Kentucky Horse Park:** The only park of its kind in the world, Kentucky Horse Park is a working horse farm, educational theme park and equine competition facility dedicated to man's relationship with the horse. The American Saddlebred Museum, the Showplace for Saddlebreds, celebrates Kentucky's first native breed of horse. The museum features interactive exhibits and a movie.

**Lake Lure Boat Tour:** Discover the beauty and charm of Lake Lure on a covered boat tour. Listen to the legends of the lake and learn about the natural and cultural history of Hickory Nut Gorge, home to Lake Lure, North Carolina.
