Henry Morrison Flagler Museum





When it was completed in 1902, the New York Herald proclaimed that Whitehall, Henry Flagler's Gilded Age estate in Palm Beach, was "more wonderful than any palace in Europe, grander, and more magnificent than any other private dwelling in the world." Today, Whitehall is a National Historic Landmark open to the public as the Flagler Museum, featuring changing exhibitions and special programs. The 75-room mansion contains many of the original furnishings as well as an art collection. Adjacent to Whitehall, the Flagler Kenan Pavilion houses Henry Flagler's private Railcar No. 91® as well as a seasonal tea service in the Railcar No 91® Tea Room, which offers a Gilded Age-themed afternoon tea. The H.M. Flagler & Co.® Museum Store offers for sale a wonderful collection of books, gifts, and memorabilia with a focus on Florida history.

Historic Kapok Tree

Standing along the picturesque Palm Beach inlet is an iconic landmark that has stood the test of time – the Historic Kapok Tree. As if straight out of a fairytale, this giant Kapok Tree boasts a remarkable history that locals and tourists can't help but marvel at. The tree's magnificent trunk boasts a circumference of over 30 feet and upwards of 60 feet in height, lending it an undeniable grandeur and sense of awe. The stunning Kapok Tree is conveniently at the Flagler Museum, beckoning visitors to take a leisurely stroll along the inlet. Whether you're a nature enthusiast or simply seeking a moment of tranquility, the Historic Kapok Tree is a must-see attraction and a gem to behold.
