Atlanta History Center is a history museum located in the Buckhead district of Atlanta, Georgia. The Museum was founded in 1926, featuring historic gardens and houses, including Swan House, Smith Farm, and Wood Family Cabin. Atlanta History Center holds one of the largest collections of Civil War artifacts in the United States. Plus, Cyclorama and the Case of America's Changing History explore the history of the Civil War through the lens of one of Georgia's most fascinating artifacts, The Battle of Atlanta: Cyclorama. At the centerpiece of this new multi-media experience is a 138-year-old hand-painted work of art that stands 49 feet tall, is longer than a football field, and weighs 10,000 pounds. This painting is one of only two cycloramas in the United States - the other being the *Battle of Gettysburg* cyclorama - making Atlanta home to one of America's largest historic treasures.

The Fox Theatre (often marketed as the Fabulous Fox), is a performing arts venue and a former movie palace and is the centerpiece of the Fox Theatre Historic District. The theater was originally planned as part of a large Shrine Temple as evidenced by its Moorish design. The 4,665-seat auditorium was ultimately developed as a lavish movie theater in the Fox Theatres chain and opened in 1929.

Georgia Aquarium in Atlanta, Georgia. The aquarium exhibits hundreds of species and thousands of animals across its seven major galleries, all of which reside in more than 11 million US gallons of water. It remains the largest aquarium in the United States and the sixth largest in the world. The aquarium's notable specimens include whale sharks, beluga whales, California sea lions, bottlenose dolphins, manta rays, sea otters, and tiger sharks. Its centerpiece is a 6.3 million US gallons whale shark exhibit.

The show features cutting-edge projection technology, stunning laser displays, and a synchronized fireworks performance set to a powerful patriotic soundtrack.


Scenic Railroad
