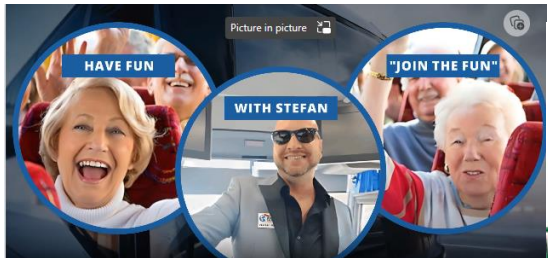
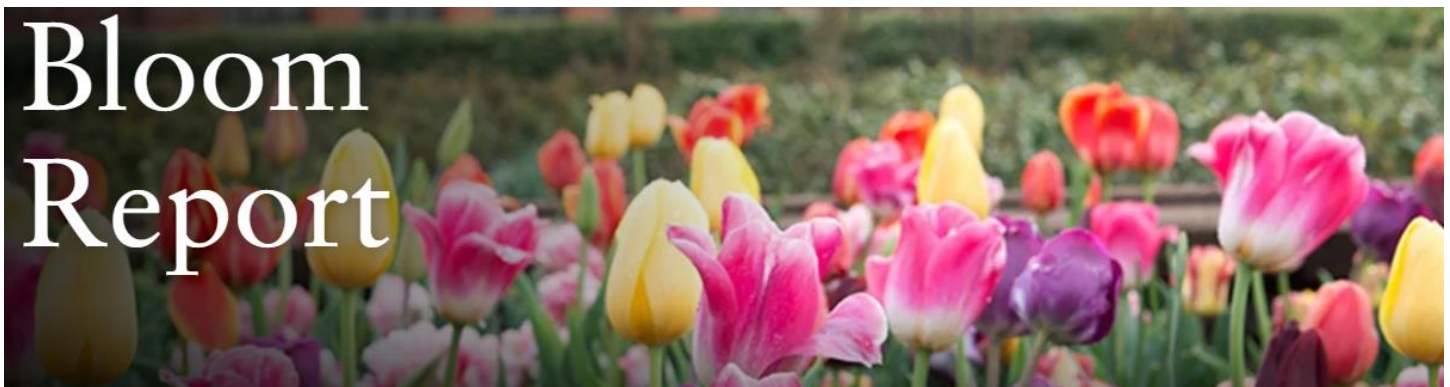


The Biltmore Spring Flower Tour April 15- 18, 2024

About the Tour:

***Biltmore estate** Celebrate Spring with a spectacular display of colorful blooms across the Biltmore estate. Starting on the first day of spring, Biltmore celebrates the legacy of Frederick Law Olmsted and his final project – George Vanderbilt’s magnificent Biltmore gardens. The bright colors in the gardens are brought inside with an opulent display of tropical plants and lavish flowers inside Biltmore House.

++++++During this festival of flowers, spring evolves with a steady progression of blooms with 100,000 bulbs planted on the estate. Tulips abound at Biltmore’s main entrance and the big display in the Walled Garden with 50,000 tulips, 14,000 daffodils and 1,000 hyacinths.

Discover Biltmore Winery, nestled in the Blue Ridge Mountains of Asheville, North Carolina on George Vanderbilt’s 8,000-acre estate. Visit our Winery and receive an introduction to our distinctive portfolio of multi-award-winning reds, whites, and rosés. Our knowledgeable wine hosts are on hand to guide your selections from among more than 20 handcrafted vintages.

***Chihuly at Biltmore* exhibition, Dale Chihuly’s** awe-inspiring works have captivated millions. A new experience of the artist’s iconic creations makes its debut at Biltmore Estate next spring. Presented in an intimate gallery setting at Amherst at Deerpark®, *Chihuly at Biltmore* includes pedestal works, *Drawings*, and large-scale installations of *Chandeliers, Towers, Mille Fiori*, and *Neon*.

***Riverbanks Zoo and Garden** is home to nearly 2,000 animals that represent more than 350 species from around the world. A visit to the Zoo will play host to an array of wild adventures from a diving expedition on a Pacific coral reef to a safari through the plains of Africa to an interactive Outback encounter with a flock of sociable lorikeets. The Botanical Garden boasts 70-acres of unparalleled beauty and is considered one of the America's best public gardens. Dramatic and themed gardens showcase more than 4,300 species of native and exotic plants, providing a living classroom for gardeners and non-gardeners alike. The Garden also is the gateway to natural river views and spectacular valley overlooks. In addition, guests can view structural remains dating back to the early 1800s with South Carolina's textile industry and the Civil War.

Enjoy a Relaxing Boat Ride with Lake Lure Boat Tours

Lake Lure Boat Tours is a wonderful way to see the beautiful lake, local attractions, and landmarks such as the location used in filming the popular Dirty Dancing movie. You will also learn a lot about the natural and cultural history of the Hickory Nut Gorge area, home to Lake Lure, North Carolina. Lastly, the homes on Lake Lure are amazing!

***Downtown Hendersonville** has the second largest downtown in western North Carolina (Asheville is the biggest), with many things to do, see and taste. Beautiful Main Street serpentine around planter boxes and lush landscaping. With more than 100 shops and 25 restaurants, it is a delight to explore the big variety of locally owned, high-quality stores, and galleries. And see their famous painted bears!
