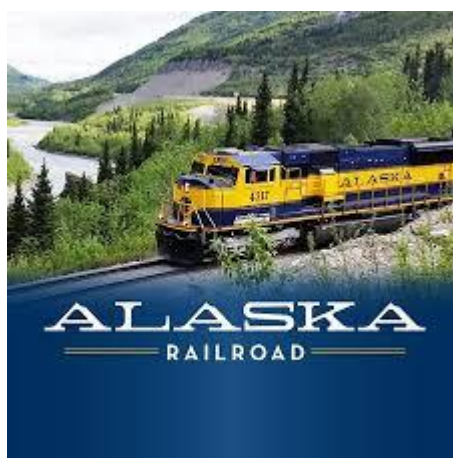

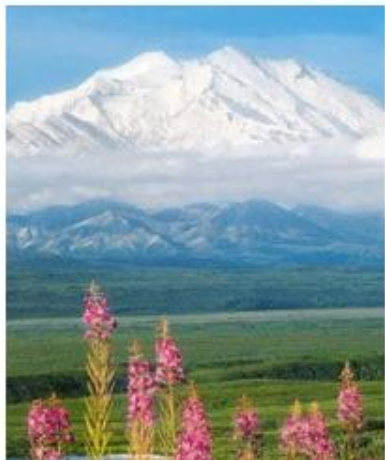
### Anchorage (Whittier), Alaska

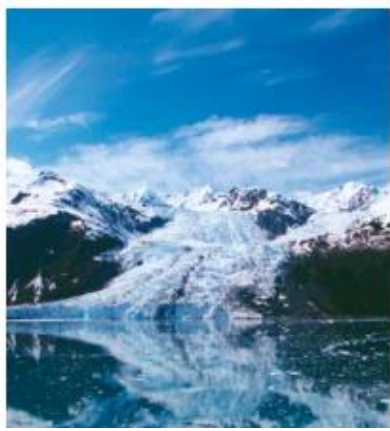
## Hubbard Glacier (Scenic Cruising), Alaska
