**Summit Skyride**-This high-speed Swiss cable car transports guests more than 825 feet above ground to the top of Stone Mountain. From the top, experience amazing views of the Atlanta skyline, the Appalachian Mountains and more up to 60 miles away.

**Scenic Railroad**- Climb aboard our train with a full-size locomotive from the 1940's. Enjoy a lively five-mile excursion around the mountain in open-air cars while you marvel at beautiful views of Stone Mountain and the surrounding landscape.

**Historic Square: A Collection of Georgia Homes and Antiques** -Explore a collection of original buildings from around the State of Georgia, built between 1793 and 1875. Each structure was moved from its original site and carefully restored.
